The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to Article 6 § 3 of the Arizona Constitution, issued Administrative Order No. 95-30 on May 10, 1995, assigning the Honorable Allen G. Minker, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Greenlee County to serve in Pinal County for the limited purpose of acting as trial judge in *Maricopa County v. Cigna Property*, Pinal County Case No. CV-95042493, and *Pima County v. Allianz Underwriters Insurance Co.*, Pinal County Case No. CV-94042423. These cases were previously transferred to the Superior Court in Pinal County for trial from the superior court in Maricopa and Pima counties.

These cases must be reassigned due to the retirement of Judge Allen G. Minker from his position as judge of the Superior Court in Greenlee County, effective December 31, 1998;

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 95-30 is rescinded and that the Honorable William J. O'Neil, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pinal County shall reassign *Maricopa County v. Cigna Property*, Pinal County Case No. CV-95042493, and *Pima County v. Allianz Underwriters Insurance Co.*, Pinal County Case No. CV-94042423 to a judge of the Superior Court in Pinal County or may request reassignment of a judge from another county to hear these cases.
