On July 12, 2001, by Administrative Order No. 2001-72, Judge Deborah Bernini was appointed as a juvenile court judge member of the Adoption and Foster Care System Improvement Committee. The term of her membership is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2003. Judge Bernini's bench assignment has been changed to the Civil Division of the Superior Court in Pima County and she is unable to fulfill her membership term on the Committee.

Session law enacted during the 1999 legislative session, Chapter 82 (SB1114), authorizes the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court to appoint two judges from the juvenile court to the Adoption and Foster Care System Improvement Committee. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Hector E. Campoy of the Superior Court in Pima County is appointed as a juvenile court judge member of the Adoption and Foster Care System Improvement Committee to complete the unexpired term of Judge Deborah Bernini which ends on June 30, 2003.
