Pursuant to Rule I(4) of the Uniform Rules of Practice of the Superior Court of Arizona, and Administrative Rule V-A III(B)(4) of Administrative Order No. 96-32, the presiding judge in each county shall appoint with the approval of the Supreme Court an associate presiding judge to act during the absence or unavailability of the presiding judge.

On November 21, 2002, by Administrative Order No. 2002-113 of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, the Honorable Colin F. Campbell, Presiding Judge, appointed the Honorable Barbara R. Mundell as Associate Presiding Judge.

Now, therefore, in accordance with the provisions of the Uniform Rules of Practice and Administrative Rule V-A cited herein,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court approves the appointment of the Honorable Barbara R. Mundell as Associate Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County and, in accordance with Rule I(7)(b), she shall serve at the pleasure of the presiding judge and exercise and discharge all powers and duties of the presiding judge, except that she may not appoint court commissioners or appoint judges permanently to special assignments.
