Administrative Order
No. 2002 - 111

Pursuant to Rule 82, Rules of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing certain members of the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee. Members of the Committee shall serve three-year terms, and terms shall be staggered as designated by the Chief Justice. Members shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed, and the appointment to fill a vacancy will be for the balance of the term.

On February 23, 2001, by Administrative Order No. 2001-30, the Honorable Manuel D. Figueroa was appointed as the Justice of the Peace member of the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee. The Court is advised that the Honorable Manuel D. Figueroa has resigned from the Committee leaving a vacancy for the remainder of the term ending on April 30, 2004. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable John S. Taylor is appointed to the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee to serve as a Justice of the Peace member for a term beginning upon entry of this Order and ending April 30, 2004.
