It appearing necessary to the administration of justice in the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, that the Honorable Noel Fidel, formerly a judge of that court and now retired, be authorized to participate and sign decisions on those cases in which he was a member of the panel, and, in accordance with the authority granted to the Chief Justice by Article 6, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED, *nunc pro tunc*, that the Honorable Noel Fidel, a retired judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, is called back to duty beginning May 1, 2002 and ending May 31, 2002, and is authorized to participate in the resolution of those cases in which he previously participated as a member of that court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the Court of Appeals, Division One, obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for the compensation and expenses due Judge Fidel pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution.
