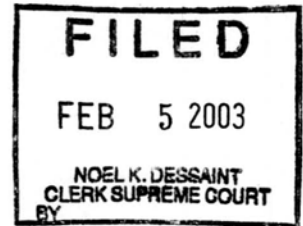

Administrative Order  
No. 2003- 18

A.R.S. §25-323.02, Laws 2002, Chapter 332, created the Domestic Relations Committee, for the purpose of revising and reforming the State's Domestic Relations Laws, Rules and Procedures and preparing a statewide plan for an integrated family court with comprehensive subject matter jurisdiction over all matters involving the family. The Chief Justice is responsible for appointing six members of the total membership of 27 to the Domestic Relations Committee, consisting of two active or retired judges or commissioners or both from the Domestic Relations Department of the Superior Court (one member from a rural county and one member from an urban county), a Clerk of the Superior Court, a representative of a conciliation court, an administrative officer of the Supreme Court, and a member of the Family Law Section of the State Bar of Arizona. Members serve at the will of the Chief Justice.

On August 23, 2002, by Administrative Order No. 2002-90, Alma Jennings Haught was appointed as the Clerk of the Superior Court member of the Domestic Relations Committee. Ms. Haught did not retain her elected position as the Clerk of the Superior Court in Pinal County and a new Clerk of the Court member must be appointed. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Beverly Frame, Clerk of the Superior Court of Yuma County, is appointed as the Clerk of Superior Court member of the Domestic Relations Committee and will serve at the will of the Chief Justice.
