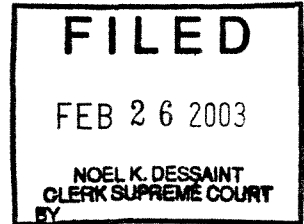

On June 21, 2002, by Administrative Order No. 2002-62, Wallace Larson was appointed as public member of the Committee on Probation. The term of his membership is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2004. Mr. Larson, citing a conflict of interest with his law firm, has resigned from the Committee.

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 90-52, which established the Committee on Probation, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members, who do not serve by virtue of their position, to the Committee on Probation. It is the discretion of the Chief Justice to appoint other members of the Committee in order to assist in the continued efforts in developing policies and procedures that improves the quality, promote standardization, consistency and coordination of probation procedures statewide. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that Michael D. Branham is appointed as a public member of the Committee on Probation to fulfill the unexpired term of Wallace Larson. Mr. Branham will serve a one-year term beginning upon entry of this order and ending June 30, 2004.
