A.R.S. § 25-323.01, Laws 2002, Chapter 332, created the Child Support Committee, previously the Child Support Coordinating Council Subcommittee, for the purpose of making recommendations regarding child support guidelines, enforcement and related issues. The Chief Justice is responsible for appointing five members of the total membership of 21 to the Child Support Committee, consisting of two Presiding Judges of the domestic relations department of the Superior Court (one Rural and one Urban), a Title IV-D Commissioner, a Clerk of the Superior Court, and a person from the Executive Committee of the Family Law Section of the State Bar of Arizona. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the following representatives are reappointed to the Child Support Committee for a period beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2005.
