Laws 2002, Chapter 319, created the State Council for Interstate Adult Offender Supervision for the purpose of exercising oversight and advocacy concerning Arizona's participation in Interstate Commission activities and other duties as determined by the Council's members. The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts with the advice and consent of the Chief Justice appoints a deputy compact administrator of the Administrative Office of the Courts. The Chief Justice appoints one judge to serve as a member of the Council.

On July 17, 2002, by Administrative Order No. 2002-76, Dora Lee Littler, Deputy Compact Administrator, and the Honorable Robert Budoff, Superior Court Judge for Maricopa County, were appointed to serve on the Council for terms ending on December 31, 2003. The business of the Council has not been completed; therefore,

Pursuant to Chapter Laws 2002, and after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED, nunc pro tunc, that Dora Lee Littler, Deputy Compact Administrator, and the Honorable Robert Budoff, Superior Court Judge for Maricopa County, are reappointed for terms beginning on January 1, 2004 and ending on December 31, 2004.
