Administrative Order
No. 2004- 07

In accordance with Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, § 1-104, the Chief Justice may establish standing committees to the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities.

Under the authority granted to the Chief Justice by the Arizona Constitution, Article VI, Section 3, the Arizona Judicial Council Achievement Awards 2004 and an awards selection committee are established. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Justice 2004 Awards shall be presented in the following areas: Protecting Children, Families and Communities; Providing Access to Swift, Fair Justice; Connecting with the Community; and Being Accountable. Two awards in each category shall be given. Nominees may be any individual in the Judicial Department, judge or court staff; a specific court project; a court team or department; or a court.

The Distinguished Service Awards shall be presented in the following areas: the Improving Public Trust and Confidence Award shall be presented to a judge at any court level; the Administration of Justice Award shall be presented to an individual non-judge employee at any level in the court system; the Chief Justice's Outstanding Contribution to the Courts Award shall be presented to an individual, project, team or court for outstanding contribution to the Judicial Department. The awards shall be presented at the Judicial Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following individuals are appointed to the Achievement Awards 2004 Selection Committee for the express purpose of considering the Achievement Awards 2004 nominations. Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Chief Justice.

The appointed members shall make award recommendations to the Arizona Supreme Court. The appointed members shall hold their appointed position beginning on this date and expiring on June 25, 2004.
