Pursuant to the provisions of Part Seven, Chapter Two of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, hearings may be conducted before hearing officers when hearings are requested by applicants denied certification by the Court's certification and licensing programs or upon the filing of a formal statement of charges against a certificate holder. For example, §7-206(H)(10) authorizes that, at the direction of the board, the chair of the Board of Certified Court Reporters or the program coordinator may select a presiding hearing officer to hold a hearing regarding the initial or renewal certification of an applicant or alleged misconduct by a certificate holder, or upon the written demand by a person entitled to a hearing. Similar provisions are found in §7-208 regarding the Board of Legal Document Preparers and §7-201 regarding the other certification and licensing programs. Further, Part Seven, Chapter Two of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration requires hearing officers to be knowledgeable in conducting hearings.

In order to permit the efficient assignment of hearing officers to preside over hearings under Part Seven, Chapter Two of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, and after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court approves the appointment of the individuals that are named below as hearing officers for the programs of the Certification and Licensing Division, to serve a three year term beginning May 1, 2004 and ending May 1, 2007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the director of the Certification and Licensing Division, the chair of a Board, or the program coordinator, as appropriate under the Code, are authorized to select or appoint any of the individuals named below to act as hearing officers.
