A.R.S. §21-222 establishes the Arizona Lengthy Trial Fund and directs the Supreme Court to administer the fund and establish rules for its administration. This fund is to be used to supplement the jury fees paid to those who serve on trials lasting more than 10 days. The statute applies to jury trials that commence on or after July 1, 2004.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §21-222,

IT IS ORDERED that the administrative director is authorized to issue procedures and forms to implement the Lengthy Trial Fund by the courts and jury commissioners in Arizona until such time as a new section of the Code of Judicial Administration can be drafted and approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall replace Administrative Order No. 2004-35 issued on June 18, 2004.
