Pursuant to Rule 3, Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases and Boating Cases, Rule 4, Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Violation Cases and A.R.S. §28-1557, the Supreme Court adopts the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint (ATTC) form and approves substantial variations in the form as it is used throughout the state.

By Administrative Order 98-31 Chief Justice Zlaket delegated authority to review and approve substantial variations in the ATTC to the Administrative Director of the Courts until June 30, 1999. The Supreme Court desires to continue that delegation and to ratify the approvals granted by the Administrative Director from the expiration date of that order.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Administrative Director of the Courts is authorized to review and approve substantial variations to the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint form pursuant to the Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases and Boating Cases and the Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Violation Cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order is effective nunc pro tunc as of July 1, 1999.
