Administrative Order <u>No. 2005 - 11</u> (Revising Administrative Order No. 2004-53)

On July 16, 2004, by Administrative Order No. 2004-53, the Court adopted Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 4-301: Priority of Offender Payments with an effective date of January 17, 2005.

Due to the complexities of the AZTEC case management system, additional analysis and programming are required to effect the necessary changes. It is the desire of the Court to provide ample time for the completion of essential analysis, programming, testing and training.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2004-53 is revised to require that ACJA § 4-30 shall be fully implemented no later than October 31, 2005.
