Pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, the Supreme Court has administrative supervision over all courts of the state through its Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

It has come to the Court's attention that the Bullhead City Court is without a Presiding Magistrate, and the Bullhead City Council has requested that the Court take over direct administration of the Bullhead City Court.

Now therefore, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED until further order of the Court, that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Bullhead City Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Randolph A. Bartlett, Presiding Judge, Superior Court in Mohave County,
