In accordance with Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution, the positions of Chief Justice and Vice Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court are created and exercise administrative supervision over all the courts of the state.

The Vice Chief Justice exercises the Court's administrative supervision over all the courts of the state in the absence or incapacity of the Chief Justice, and in accordance with Article VI, Section 7 of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court shall appoint an Administrative Director and staff to serve at its pleasure to assist the Chief Justice in discharging his administrative duties.

Extraordinary emergency situations may arise within the State Courts Building or at a local court requiring administrative action during which both the Chief Justice and Vice Chief Justice are unavailable.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 and Section 7, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that whenever the Chief Justice and Vice Chief Justice are unavailable, and immediate administrative action is required, the Administrative Director is authorized to exercise the Court's administrative authority to take the required action. In the absence of the Administrative Director, the Deputy Administrative Director is authorized to act.
