On November 22, 2002, Administrative Order No. 2002-107 was entered establishing a two-year Complex Litigation Program in the Superior Court in Maricopa County and the Complex Civil Litigation Court Evaluation Committee. Under Administrative Order No. 2002-107 and No. 2003-52, members were appointed to the Committee for the duration of the program. By Administrative Order No. 2004-27, the program and committee were extended to December 31, 2006.

The Chairman of the Committee and the Presiding Judge in the Superior Court in Maricopa County has requested a two-year extension of the pilot program to allow additional time to evaluate its effectiveness. After due consideration of their request,

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Complex Civil Litigation Pilot Program is extended to December 31, 2008.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the terms of the Committee members previously appointed and identified in the attached Appendix A are extended to December 31, 2008.
