Pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, the Supreme Court has administrative supervision over all courts of the state through its Administrative Office of the Court (AOC).

The Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2005-61 on September 1, 2005, ordering that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Bullhead City Court be assumed by the Honorable Randolph A. Bartlett, Presiding Judge of Superior Court in Mohave County.

It is the desire of the Supreme Court that the Honorable Randolph A. Bartlett, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Mohave County, return administrative control and oversight of the Bullhead City Court to the Presiding Judge of the Bullhead City Court in light of the court's appointment of the Bullhead City Court Presiding Magistrate. Now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2005-61 is rescinded.
