The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County has requested the assignment of a judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals to serve in that court to aid and assist in the consideration and disposition of all matters relating to *State v. Bradley Kennedy*, CR2003-031405. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to his regular duties as a judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals, the Honorable Patrick Irvine is assigned in the above-designated matter, as designated by the presiding judge.

While serving as a judge in the designated matter, the above-named judge shall have all the powers and duties of a judge of the Superior Court. These powers and duties shall extend beyond the period of this assignment for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of this cause heard in whole or in part during the period of this assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by Judge Irvine to serve in the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County for the above designated matter and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
