The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, periodically conducts reviews and audits of court operations.

The Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2006-36 on April 19, 2006, ordering administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Surprise City Court be assumed by the Honorable Barbara Mundell, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County.

It is the desire of the Supreme Court that the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County return administrative control of the Surprise City Court to the Honorable Michael Lester, Interim Presiding Judge of the Surprise City Court, pending recruitment and selection of a new presiding judge of the Surprise City Court. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2006-36 is rescinded.
