In accordance with Rule 49, Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Supreme Court is responsible for appointment of members to the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona. There are two attorney member vacancies and three public member vacancies. One incumbent public member of the Disciplinary Commission has indicated her desire to be reappointed for another term. Rule 49 permits incumbent members to be reappointed for one consecutive three-year term.

It is advisable for the existing Commission members to continue to serve until October 31, 2006 and for the new terms to begin on November 1, 2006.

Therefore, after consideration of the recommendations submitted by the Disciplinary Commission, pursuant to Rule 49 (a), Rules of the Supreme Court,
