Administrative Order No. 2006- 86

During the 2006 legislative session, Senate Bill 1371 was introduced requiring the establishment of a Joint Legislative Study Committee on Global Position System Monitoring.

In accordance with Senate Bill 1371, Sec. 4, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing two judges, one of whom is from a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand persons and one of whom is from a county with a population of less than five hundred thousand persons; two probation officers, one of whom is from a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand persons and one of whom is from a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand persons; and one of whom is from a county with a population of less than five hundred thousand persons; and one representative of the administrative office of the courts who has experience with the provision of probation services. Therefore,
