Pursuant to the request of the Presiding Judge in Cochise County, and it appearing necessary to the administration of justice that the Honorable Thomas Collins, a retired judge of that court, be authorized to participate in and sign decisions and, in accordance with the authority granted to the Chief Justice by Article 6, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Thomas Collins, a retired judge of the Superior Court in Cochise County, is called back to duty for a term beginning January 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2008, and is authorized to participate in the resolution of cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the Cochise County Board of Supervisors and the Superior Court in Cochise County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for the compensation and expenses due Judge Collins pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution.
