Laws 2006, Ch. 308 amended A.R.S. § 38-893 to authorize establishment of a local board that is responsible to administer and make effective the Correctional Officer Retirement Plan for probation officers, surveillance officers and juvenile detention officers employed by the Superior Court of Arizona. The statute provides that the board shall have two members who are elected by secret ballot by members who are employed as a probation, surveillance or juvenile detention officer, a designee of the chief justice of the Arizona Supreme Court, and two citizens, one of whom shall be the head of a human resource department for the group of members, appointed by the chief justice. The statute also provides that one elective and one appointive board member, as designated by the appointing authority, shall serve a term ending two years after the date of appointment or election, and the other local board members shall serve a term ending four years after the date of appointment or election and that, thereafter, vacancies shall be filled for a term of four years in the same manner as each office was originally filled.

Now, therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-893 and the administrative supervisory authority provided by Az. Const. Art. 6, § 3,

IT IS ORDERED that Kevin Kluge is designated to serve as a member of the Correctional Officer Retirement Plan Local Board for the Superior Court for a two-year term.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Phillip Hanley, the head of the human resources department of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, is appointed to serve on the Correctional Officer Retirement Plan Local Board for the Superior Court for a four-year term.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jim Bruner is appointed to serve as Chair of the Correctional Officer Retirement Plan Local Board for the Superior Court for a four-year term.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all terms shall begin on February 8, 2007. Dated this 8th day of February, 2007.
