During the 2007 legislative session, Senate Bill 1231 was passed requiring the continuation of a Joint Legislative Study Committee on Global Position System Monitoring.

In accordance with Senate Bill 1231, Sec. 1(A)(3) and (4), the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing two judges, one of whom is from a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand persons and one of whom is from a county with a population of less than five hundred thousand persons; two probation officers, one of whom is from a county with a population of more than five hundred thousand persons and one of whom is from a county with a population of less than five hundred thousand persons; and one representative of the administrative office of the courts who has experience with the provision of probation services.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Senate Bill 1231 and Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,
