In accordance with Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 1-104, the Chief Justice may establish advisory committees to the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. On December 20, 2007, by Administrative Order No. 2007-101, the Advisory Committee on Supreme Court Rule 123 and Data Dissemination was established to examine and make recommendations on access to records maintained by the judiciary in the areas of bulk data, database access, data retention, case look-up websites, and any other Rule 123 issues the Committee determined needed resolution. The individuals listed on Appendix A were appointed as members of the Committee with terms ending December 31, 2008.

The Committee reported its recommendations to the Arizona Judicial Council on December 2, 2008, however the Committee needs to carry out additional work to complete its charge, including filing and circulating a rule petition and addressing any comments to the petition, as well as preparing an Arizona Code of Judicial Administration section to support the proposed rule changes. It is advisable that the Committee continue its work into 2009.

Therefore, after consideration of the report and recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Supreme Court Rule 123 and Data Dissemination,

IT IS ORDERED that the individuals listed on Appendix A are reappointed as members of the Advisory Committee on Supreme Court Rule 123 and Data Dissemination with terms ending December 31, 2009.
