On April 9, 2008, Administrative Order No. 2008-34 was issued to clarify the disposition codes that courts are required to use in reporting to MVD. However, it has come to the attention of the Administrative Office of the Courts that a disposition code was not included in the Administrative Order, which requires revising and replacing Administrative Order No. 2008-34.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the attached disposition codes are adopted for use by all Arizona courts when recording case dispositions or when reporting case dispositions to non-judicial agencies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that courts may continue to adopt additional disposition codes to accommodate their operations, so long as they are used for internal purposes only. All reporting of traffic violation status external to the court of jurisdiction shall be accomplished by using the attached codes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, nunc pro tunc, that this order is effective May 15, 2008 and replaces Administrative Order No. 2008-34.
