In accordance with Rule 32(c)(6) and 32(d)(1) of the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, an annual membership fee shall be established by the Board of Governors of the State Bar of Arizona with the consent of the Court.

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Governors to reduce the Client Protection Fund annual assessment from \$30 to \$10 and that the \$20 difference be redirected to the State Bar of Arizona operating fund. It is anticipated that this adjustment will alleviate the need to increase the net dues amount until 2011 or beyond.

Now, therefore, in accordance with the administrative authority vested in the Supreme Court by Rule 32(c)(3), Rule 32(c)(6) and Rule 32(c)(7) of the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Court has considered the annual fee for membership in the State Bar of Arizona; and

IT IS ORDERED that the changes in annual membership fees for the State Bar of Arizona be adopted and effective as follows:
