Administrative Order No. 2008-15 adopted several amendments to the above-captioned code section and set an effective date coincident with full implementation of the new statewide case management system or any new or reprogrammed financial system, and "no later than January 1, 2010." Until that time, the Order directed that each court be governed by the unamended version of § 3-401. Administrative Order No. 2009-24 adopted a technical amendment to the code section amended by Administrative Order No. 2008-15.

Scheduled implementation of the new statewide case management system in several counties and programming required for the case management system in use by the Clerk of Court in Maricopa County require an extension of the January 1, 2010 deadline set forth in Administrative Order No. 2008-15.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2008-15 is amended to require that all courts implement the revisions to ACJA § 3-401 adopted by that Order no later than January 1, 2011.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the unamended version of § 3-401 shall be published along with the version amended by Administrative Order Nos. 2008-15 and 2009-24 until January 1, 2011.
