During the 48th Legislature Second Regular Session, House Bill 2210 passed, authorizing establishment of the state photo enforcement program. The legislation further authorized creation of the Department of Public Safety photo enforcement fund and appropriated monies from the fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts for processing of state photo enforcement citations.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Administrative Director or his designee is authorized to spend these funds to implement electronic citation processing in justice courts statewide including, but not limited to, making software programming changes, computer hardware and software acquisitions, and expanding bandwidth and improving utilization of the Arizona Judicial Information Network as necessary to handle the increased data traffic.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Director may authorize the allocation and distribution of monies to local courts to assist in covering the cost incurred to implement photo enforcement and process the citations.
