ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 83-14

IT IS ORDERED that, upon denial of a petition for review of a decision of the Court of Appeals, the clerk of the Supreme Court shall transmit to the clerk of the Court of Appeals the original copies of all responses to the petition(s) for review, cross-petition(s) for review, original motions and other original papers filed in this Court, along with the original pleadings and papers filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the Court of Appeals shall be responsible for preserving the original papers filed in the Supreme Court with respect to petitions for review that have been denied by the Supreme Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall apply only to those petitions for review filed pursuant to the Arizona Rules of Court in effect on September 1, 1983, but shall not apply to petitions for review in juvenile matters.
