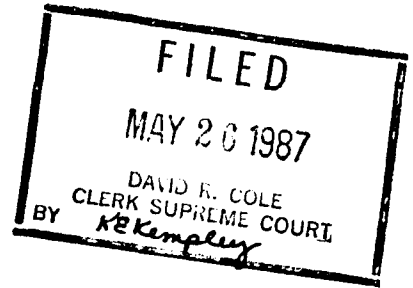


SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA

Administrative Order No. 87-20
