Administrative Order No. 87-26

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 87-17, the Chief Justice may appoint advisory committees of the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. In order to assure the effective statewide implementation of child support and visitation legislation recently signed into law and child support guidelines to be adopted by the Supreme Court, and to assist in developing and coordinating child support related policies, procedures and programs for the judiciary statewide, now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An Advisory Committee on Child Support is created to advise the Council on Judicial Administration on all relevant child support issues.
2. The Chairman of the Child Support Advisory Committee may, at his discretion, appoint sub-committees and task forces as may be necessary to assist the Advisory Committee in carrying out its responsibilities.
