COMMITTEE ON RISK MANAGEMENT

Administrative Order No. 88-2

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 87-17, the Chief Justice may establish advisory committees to the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An advisory committee on risk management is hereby established as a committee of the Council on Judicial Administration and shall be known as the Committee on Risk Management.

2. The purposes of this committee shall be to examine the areas of liability within the court system, to determine the most appropriate methods of managing potential risks, and to develop an annual risk management plan pursuant to statutory requirements. Areas that may be examined by this committee include, but are not limited to, probation and detention, a statewide loss control program, a self-audit guide, judicial immunity and the extension of judicial immunity to others in the court system, and risk management training programs.

3. Committee leadership and members of the committee shall be appointed by the Chief Justice.
