**APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO PREPARE  
A PAMPHLET FOR VICTIMS AND OTHER WITNESSES**

Administrative Order No. 89 - 9

The court finds it appropriate to appoint a committee of persons familiar with the needs and concerns of victims and other witnesses to develop and publish a pamphlet addressing the role of victims and other witnesses in the criminal justice system and designed to help these persons be knowledgeable participants at each point of contact with the system. Now, therefore pursuant to the supervisory authority granted in Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED THAT a special committee is hereby established whose duties include developing a pamphlet for victims and other witnesses who participate in the criminal justice process and obtaining by grant or other appropriate means the funding necessary to publish the pamphlet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the committee be composed of a county attorney/Attorney General representative, a public defender representative, a judge, a private attorney, a victim/witness counselor, a citizen victim/witness, a probation officer, and two legislative representatives to be appointed by the Chief Justice.
