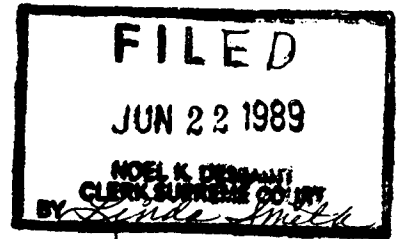

Administrative Order No. 89-13

In accordance with Administrative Order 87-17, the Chief Justice may establish advisory committees to the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An advisory committee on video transcription is hereby established as a committee to the Council on Judicial Administration and shall be known as the Committee on Video Transcription.

2. The purpose of the Committee is to review and report on the feasibility of using video transcription as a means of providing records of proceedings in the trial courts.
