ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 91- 24

WHEREAS:

1. House Bill 2412 was recently enacted by the Legislature to ensure that Article II, Section 2.1, Constitution of Arizona, is fully and fairly implemented and that all crime victims are provided with basic rights of respect, protection, participation and healing of their ordeals;

2. Article 6, Section 3, Constitution of Arizona, provides that the Supreme Court shall have administrative supervision over all the courts of the State;

IT IS ORDERED that an advisory Implementation Committee on Victims' Rights is hereby created to advise the Supreme Court on the implementation of the Victims' Rights Implementation Act. The committee will assist the Administrative Office of the Courts in developing and implementing any administrative orders, rule changes, and training needed by the courts to fully and fairly implement the Act.
