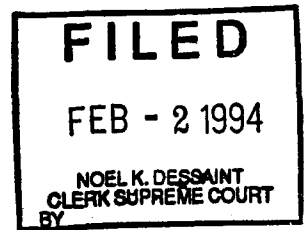


SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA
APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMITTEE
ON JUDICIAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 94-7



In Administrative Order 92-7, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members of the Committee on Judicial Education and Training to monitor the quality of education programs in the Arizona court system, recommend changes in education policies and standards and approve guidelines for accrediting training programs.
