Mesa Municipal Court has requested an exception to Rule III(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, and Rule 4(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Cases, to allow the City of Mesa to implement a pilot program using hand-held/automated traffic citation devices that electronically capture the data presently written by hand on the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint form and print out a small form for the violator/defendant and the court. Although the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint forms will be substantially smaller than the 8½ by 11 inches required under the rules, the data captured through this method will not vary substantially from the data presently required by the rules except in format. Good cause having been shown,

IT IS ORDERED that Mesa Municipal Court is granted an exception to Rule III(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, and Rule 4(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Cases, to allow the City of Mesa to implement the pilot program outlined above. This exception shall be in effect from June 3, 1995 through and including June 30, 1996.
