

## DISQUALIFICATION AND REASSIGNMENT OF JUDGE

Administrative Order No. 95-\_61

The Court has been notified that William L. Scholl, a Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County, has been indicted in the United States District Court for the District of Arizona for violations of 26 U.S.C. § 7206(a), a felony, and 26 U.S.C. § 5324, a felony. Therefore, pursuant to article 6.1, § 2 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Judge William L. Scholl is disqualified from acting as a judge while the felony indictment is pending. As required by article 6.1, § 2, Judge Scholl shall continue to receive his salary during the period of his disqualification.

Article 6, § 3 provides that the Chief Justice may specially assign judges. Therefore,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judge Scholl is specially assigned to perform such non-judicial duties as may be directed by Judge Michael J. Brown, Pima County Presiding Judge.
