Order No. 95-28)

On April 19, 1995, by Administrative Order No. 95-28, Mesa Municipal Court was granted an exception to Rule III(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, as well as an exception to Rule 4(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Cases. This Court also granted permission to the City of Mesa to implement a pilot program using hand-held traffic citation devices. Said exception and pilot program were in effect through June 30, 1996.

Mesa Municipal Court now requests an extension of the rule exceptions and an extension of the pilot program as additional time is needed for the test period and, assuming the data gathered supports continued use of this technology and of this program, adequate time is needed to circulate the information to the appropriate parties for a possible rule change.

IT IS ORDERED that Mesa Municipal Court is granted an extension to Administrative Order No. 95-28 to grant a continuation of their exception to Rule III(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, and also an exception Rule 4(a), Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Cases. This extension will allow the City of Mesa to continue the pilot program to use hand-held/automated traffic citation devices (as specifically described in Administrative Order No. 95-28). Further, the extension shall be in effect from July 1, 1996, through June 30, 1997.
