Administrative Order  
No. 97- 24  
(Rescinding Administrative  
Order No. 96-15)

Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 96-15, entered April 17, 1996, procedures for scheduling the transfer of physical custody of juvenile offenders from the juvenile courts to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections (ADJC) were established. However, due to the resolution on May 5, 1997 of the consent decree which gave rise to the issuance of Administrative Order No. 96-15, the juvenile courts can resume their normal operations for transferring custody of committed juvenile offenders to the ADJC.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 96-15 be rescinded.
