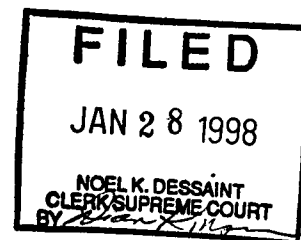

On December 19, 1997, by Administrative Order No. 97-70, the Court adopted revised procedures and forms for granting fee deferrals and/or waivers of court fees and costs. That administrative order further ordered that any modifications to the forms "must have the approval of the Chief Justice, or his/her designee."

Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 97-70, the Chief Justice desires to appoint the Administrative Director as his designee, to review and approve any modifications to the forms as adopted by that order.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution;

IT IS ORDERED that the Administrative Director of the Courts is the appointed designee of the Chief Justice to review and approve any modifications to the fee deferral and waiver forms which were adopted by Administrative Order No. 97-70.
