In accordance with Rule III, Arizona Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, and Rule 4, Arizona Rules of Procedure in Civil Traffic Violation Cases, require approval from the Supreme Court for "any substantial variation from the form of the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint" form as set forth in appendices to the Rules.

On September 4, 1996, by Administrative Order 96-42, then Chief Justice Stanley G. Feldman ordered that, on behalf of the Supreme Court, the Administrative Director of the Courts could approve any substantial variation from the form of the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint form for a period from September 4, 1996, until July 1, 1998. Administrative Office Staff continue development of guidelines for form approval and request an extension of the 1996 order through June 30, 1999.

Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 96-42 be extended from July 1, 1998, through June 30, 1999, in order that, on behalf of the Supreme Court, the Administrative Director of the Courts may continue to approve any substantial variation from the form of the Arizona Traffic Ticket and Complaint form.
