Administrative Order

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4041, as amended effective July 18, 1996, the Supreme Court is to establish and maintain a list of qualified candidates eligible for appointment as counsel for indigent capital defendants in state post-conviction proceedings. Pursuant to Art. 6, § 3 of the Arizona Constitution, on December 27, 1996, the Court, by administrative order No. 96-63, established the Committee on the Appointment of Counsel for Indigent Defendants in Capital Cases.
