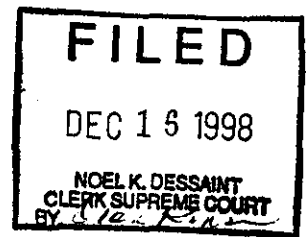

Administrative Order
No. 98- 78
(Revising Administrative
Order No. 90-23)

In accordance with Rule 31(c)6. of the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, an annual membership fee shall be established by the Board of Governors of the State Bar of Arizona with the consent of this Court.

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Governors to increase the annual membership fees, the Court has considered the recommendation of the Board and desires to approve new fees.

Now, therefore, in accordance with the administrative authority vested in the Supreme Court by Rule 31(a) and Rule 31(c)6 of the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Court has considered the annual fee for membership in the State Bar of Arizona; and

IT IS ORDERED that the changes in annual membership fees for the State Bar of Arizona be adopted and effective as follows:

1. **Members with 3+ years of experience:**
Effective: January 1, 1999 January 1, 2000 January 1, 2001
 \$320 \$340 \$360

2. **Members with less than 3 years experience:**
Effective: January 1, 1999 January 1, 2000 January 1, 2001
 \$125 \$145 \$165

3. **Inactive Members:**
Effective: January 1, 1999 January 1, 2000 January 1, 2001
 \$125 \$145 \$165

4. **Retired Members:**
 Effective: January 1, 1999 January 1, 2000 January 1, 2001
 \$95 \$115 \$135
5. **Judicial Members:**
 Effective: January 1, 1999 January 1, 2000 January 1, 2001
 \$175 \$195 \$215

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State Bar shall continue to appropriate and disburse funds collected from these annual membership fees in accordance with Rule 31 of the Arizona Rules of Supreme Court.
