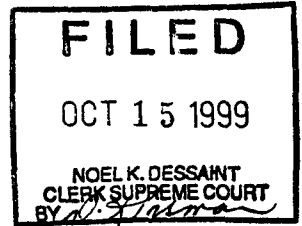


Administrative Order
No. 99- 67

Pursuant to Rule 82, Rules of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members to the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee. On June 1, 1999, the Court amended Rule 82 to increase the membership of the Committee from seven members to nine members. One of the two members shall be a judge from any court in Arizona, and one shall be a non-judge. Members shall serve three-year terms, staggered as designated by the Chief Justice.

Now, therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Colin Campbell, Superior Court in Maricopa County, and David Withey, attorney-at-law, hereby are appointed as members of the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee, and in order to comply with established, staggered term expiration dates, for terms effective from this date and expiring on April 30, 2002.
