

PRO TEMPORE ORDER
No. 99 - 90

The presiding judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County has requested the appointment of a Judge Pro Tempore to serve in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. The Coconino County Board of Supervisors has approved the appointment of a Judge Pro Tempore.

Now, therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED that Robert B. Van Wyck hereby is appointed a Judge Pro Tempore in the Superior Court in Coconino County in the manner provided in A.R.S. §§ 12-141 through 12-144, from December 1, 1999, through December 31, 1999, or at the pleasure of the Supreme Court, to serve on a specific day or days as determined by the presiding judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 50% of Judge Van Wyck's salary shall be paid by the Arizona Supreme Court and 50% by Coconino County.
