Discussion: Discussion regarding 2009 Board Meetings to be held every other month rather than monthly raises concerns certification applications will not be reviewed and approved quickly enough. The average time to process an application is between 50 and 55 days. Fingerprint background checks can take up to six weeks. The 2009 Board schedule provides for potential Board review every 60 days. Mr. McDonald, representative of Arizona Court Reporters association, spoke regarding possible legislative changes. Ms. Grau said 2009 Meeting Schedule was to be an interim solution and not meant to be permanent.
