8 This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of  
9 Arizona on December 11, 2004, pursuant to Rule 58(e), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of  
10 the Hearing Officer's Report filed October 21, 2004 recommending acceptance of the  
11 Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint  
12 Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum)  
13 providing for a six month suspension, probation upon reinstatement (terms to be determined  
14 at the reinstatement hearing) and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

16 **Decision**

17 The nine<sup>1</sup> members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and  
18 incorporating by reference the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law and  
19 recommendation for a six month suspension, probation upon reinstatement (terms to be  
20 determined at the reinstatement hearing) and costs. The Hearing Officer's Report is
